

TURKEY SHOOT

REGISTRATION ON-SITE AT 9:00 AM

Turkey shoot will be held at Buz Meyer's Range (see map on next page).

Classes:

Class 1:	8-10 years old	} Same Class Break Down for Archery Shooters
Class 2:	11-13 years old	
Class 3:	14-19 years old	
Class 4:	Adult women	
Class 5:	Adult men	

Classes 1, 2, and 4 shoot from 25 yards.
Classes 3 and 5 shoot from 50 yards.

SHOOTING:

Each participant will fire five shots. In the event of a tie, contestants will be allowed one more shot. Participants may fire from prone, sitting, kneeling, or standing position. NOTE: If you will not be standing, bring a mat, blanket, or other ground cover to put under you.

RIFLE:

.22 caliber Rimfire Rifle as defined in NRA Rule 3.1 below. Hooked Butt plates are not permitted.

3.1 The Rifle: The rifle authorized for use in small bore rifle matches is the .22 caliber rimfire chambered for cartridges commercially catalogued as the ".22 Short," ".22 Long," or ".22 Long Rifle" cartridges. There are not restrictions on the barrel length or overall weight of the rifle and accessories. No portion of the rifle or any attachment to the rifle shall extend more than 3 inches beyond the rear of the shooters shoulder. The trigger pull must be capable of lifting 3 pounds.

SIGHTS:

Iron sights only (NRA Rule 3.7A below). No scopes allowed. Hoods without glass or magnifying devices are permitted.

- 3.7 Sights
- (a) Metallic
 - (1) Non-corrective; any sighting system constructed of metal or equivalent, which provides a method of aiming or aligning 2 separate but visible sights or reference points, mounted on the rifle, including tube sights and non-magnifying color filters.

TARGET:

Official NRA 50 yards – A-23.

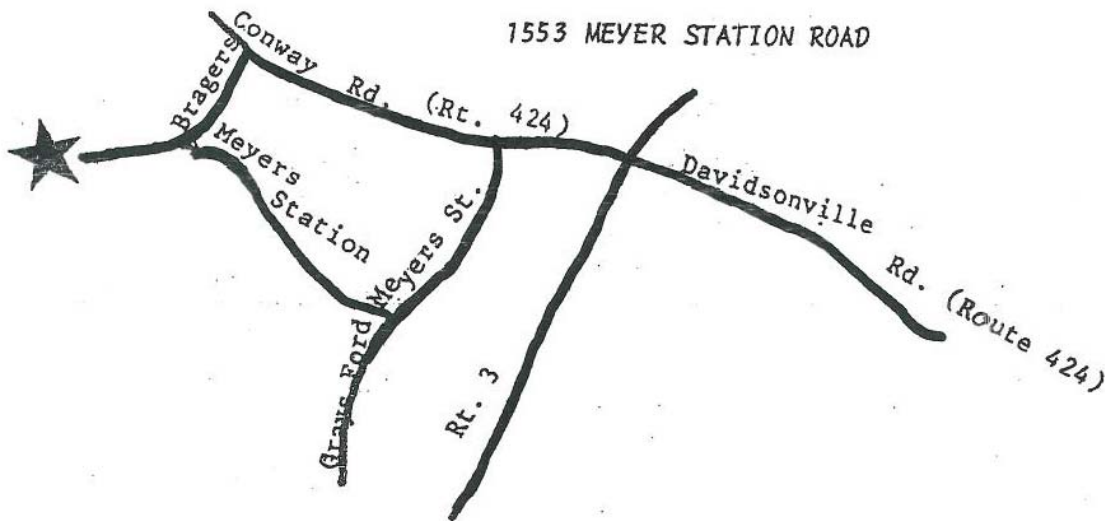
AMMUNITION:
